

Mod. Arab. Measuras, (six-shoots)

seven times - "one-seven" in Law.

of Jer 16. 18, which has never been explained, perhaps an Aramaism -

one - two, i.e. twice.  
first - two

really good Aramaic idiom.

cf. Cowley 30. 3 one - thousand;  
= a thousand times.

Similar a seldom understood case in the Gospels - story of the Sower

~~Math. 13. 8~~ Luke 8. 8 ~~an~~ - a hundred etc.

the same idiom.

often misunderstood as 'in a hundred', misunderstood by the Hellenists, hence the text became very corrupt.
