

We have chariots ~~of iron~~ as early as the fourth century.

● But iron chariots would seem probably to have come in with the Philistines.

Chariots originally drawn by donkeys.

By the 15th ~~century~~ century the horse becomes very popular.

Horse introduced into Egypt by Hyksos. Prob. unknown in Palestine before.

● about 1500 B.C., earliest document in pure Indo-European we have, — written in Hittite, with pure Sanskrit technical terms — is a description of training of horses for chariots. Comes from Mitanni.

Art of riding horseback is very late — certainly well in first millennium.

Earliest ~~the~~ writing of any length in Indo-Eur. from India, ^{written down} comes from ^{3rd} 3rd century.
