The final 5 perhaps an addition.

Perhaps the name comes from
Anatolia - hence same word in
Indo-European and Hebrew.

In Anatolian 5 is a common
ending, perhaps a determinative.

Sound 7 uncommon in Anatolia.

Perhaps η more original.

No root 172 in Semitic.

Probably iron brought from Anatolia,
and the name brought with it.

Assyrian iron brought from
Pentus (in Anatolia) as we know
from Assyrian inscriptions.
