

In Assy. *haranu* means both road and caravan.

First known reference to Canaan is in Kirkuk tablet, referring to ~~the fact~~ that a caravan returning from the west bring back Canaanite wool.

v. 7 the second word is simply transliterated in *aqwila* & *theodotus*

In an older form *zfs* could end in *z* cf. Ruth. 3 Ezek. 16, Mi

cf. Ezek. Jer 2, 20, where it is suggested that the form might be better, ^{take} _{as 2nd person}

Prob. that form was *anceps*, the vowel being either long or short.

v. 12 & v 15 support, though not proving 2nd person.

LXX takes 3rd person
