Much of the archaeological work in Palestine has been done within the last decade and some of it is of very far reaching importance. We shall now glance briefly at its history and its principles, and **the** shall look more in detail at sections of it as we survey the important places of Palestine. as well as different parts of its history. I wish now that each member of the class would thoroughly review the lectures so far and then would run over the outstanding features of Old Testament history, noticing the names of the most important places at the different periods, beginning the time of Abraham.
