Prophets 15.

I mean that which God gives to the prophet, new ideas suggested to the mind of the prophet from the Lord. By inspiration I mean that the whole of the Scripture is kept by the Holy Spirit from error. Now if in the Scripture Paul tells Timothy, "The cloak that I left at Troas, bring with thee", that is not a revelation from God. God did not reveal to Paul (that is, so far as we know He didn't) the fact that it was at Troas he'd left the cloak. Paul noticed the cloak was missing and thought that was where he'd forgotten it or else Paul had intentionally left it there because
