the issue at hand and condemned Nestorius. Now the Antiocans were not yet there. Now the bishops present phantalogic unamamously applied that whoever did not anathamatize Nestorius let himself be anthame , they true faith anathamatized him and the whole council anathamatized him . And they went on in a ery stong condemnation of Nestorius, and they thought that he should be put down from his bishophood and excumnicated as a heretic and then a few days later John arrived with 40 bishops with him buth hew was unable to follow the extreme view that Nestorius and he tried to mediate and he did not get very far in it and the result was he did not oppose the condemnation of Nestorius and the meeting had several cessions and finally both partied appealed to the emperor, the emperor had favored Nestorius in the past and now he was beginning to wonder if that was right when he saw so manh against him and he he saw the aged invenerable monk and leaders who were taking the other side and finally the emperor well we will simply depose the leaders of both sides and so he took Nestorius and Cyril and put them both in prison and he gave his approval to the council and he summoned a spokkeman from both partieds to meet him in confidence and there they met and after a time they agreeded to have Nestorius debansahed and his view condemned and Cyril was released and allowed to go back to his leadership in Alexandrraa. And so as a result anoth another thing they did was to condamn pelagianism, but they took a very strong stand against Nestorius and his divisino of Christ into two #15/16/ distinct persons . I don't tink that Nestorius meant it that way but they Cyril wrote a staement which brought in the belief in of the two natures although stressing the unity of the person the people of Antioch gave their agreement to it and agreed to anathama tize the wicked and unholy innovations of Nestorius. And so in 433 in general the church was agreed in Antioch and in Alexandria the new leaders in Constantinople were all agreed upon it and that Nestorius was sent into exile sent to a place and then sent to another island and hew was drug from place to another like Chrysostom had been but he seems to have been to have endured his suffering and with independence and wrote his life
