had hunted around and had found the man. He had disappeared, and they accused Athanacious of having murdered him, but the man was found and bearingxix brought to the council. And there they brought him in withxhixx covered up with cloaks, so nobody would realize what was happening, and then Athanacious said, are there any of you here who know this man. And several said, we know him when he was living, and then he stepped up to this man andxpsxjixxixx pulled his coat off from the side of his face, and said, is this he, and they said, k yes, that is he. And know Athanacious said, well, look, he has got two hands, where is the third one I am supposed to have cut off his body? (laughter)

And there is one story that they brugs brought a woman to the council, who accused Athanacious of having had wicked reattionships with her, and one of Athanacious Krimmin presbyters had presence of mind, and he jumped up and turned to the woman and said, are you really going to accuse me of this, and she not knowing the people, she had been brought in, hired for this purpose, she said, oh yes, I am going to do it. And then everybody saw that she didn't even know who Athanacious was, and in that way it was solved. (laughter) There were a number of times like that, in such waxxx ways as his things were proven to be false. Nevertheless, when he had been bishop for ten years, a council of people of Arian sympathies, after hearing these charges, and later accounts his friends tell us they were answered in such ways as this, nevertheless voted to depose him from his bishopric and Athanacious went to Constantinople to see the emperor to get justice. And the emperor wrote a letter wxxxxxx to the bishops in which he told them that Athanacious had come into the x city on his horse, and a short fellow had stepped up and seized the bridle of his horse, and said he wanted to speak to him, and he hadn't recognized the man, and he told him to get out of the way, and the man said, I must speak with you, and then he looked close and saw that it was Athanacious and that the emperor said no I haven't time to hear you, and he said well I am being very unjustly treated and you must hear AMEX Athanacious said in his letter, he went to Constantinople to see
