in suffer ing for Christianity against Julian. And so the orthodox g faith was ket; helped by it, and then when Julian died and the soldiers elected a young man about thirty, a rough soldier, to be the emperor in his place, there were no relatives, because all the relatives had been killed when Constantius became ruler, they elected this man to become emperor in his place, and this man was a Christian who followed the Nicean form of Christianity.

And nobody knows what might have appened if this man had proved, he was a good soldier, and he proved to have ability in administration, and had become a great leader with the rex principles he had. But in eight months he died, as you know, This is number 6, 363 to 381.

Now we wath to say something, of course, about the political situation during these years, but it is not nearly as important to us as the political situation during the years before. So, I am going here, instead of taking up the plitical situation first, I am going to go on with the Arian controversy here, but we have to just give the main facts as a background of it.

NEXWARE I would like you to know the facts. of course, that Julian was succeeded by **/a real Christian, but he did not reign long enough to have any great importance in the *** history.

After eight months, one evening he was busy with administrative affairs, and it was a cold night, and he had a charcoal grate, here, burning burning in the room. They didn't have central heat, you know, in those days, and he had this charcoal grate, here, burning in the room, trying to keep his fingers warm while he was writing his notes. *And while he was going over his administrative work, he worked late at night, dismissed everyone, and continued works ing there, and the next morning they found him dead in the room. And evidently the charcoal fumes had asphixiated him. He had probably become very tired and fallen asleep and the charcoal went on burning and normally it would have been put out and he would have retired and gone into another room, *a or something would have been done. At any rate, he died after only eight months. And all the Christian writers said, later on, that
