God did not permit the good Johian to have as long a reign as the wicked J lian had had before, in order that no one would stand for \mathbf{x} truth and Christiantty simply for the sake of the good things that he might get from it. Now that is, of course, a philosophic judgment of that, which is not necessrily true, but I think it is interesting.

Well, wf Johian, when he died, the empire was divided again. It was a pretty hard job to administer an empire as large as this anyway. It was very difficult. And of course in those days without telegraph, without telephones, without the transportation that we have today, it was particularly difficult, and of course the barbarians on the outside had been pressing in for three centuries, but more so in this last century than ever before. And Do Diocletian, a century earlier, thought it wise to divide the empire. Valens Now his two brothers, Valentinian and Yatenes became emperor. Vlaentinian ruled int in the west, Valens ruled in the east. Valentinian ruled in the west for eleven years. Valens, in the a east, lived longer. He ruled for thritean years. And Valentinian, in the west, favored the Nicean view, which was the view which was more preferred in the west. But Valens, in the east, was favorable to the Arian view. And the result is that during his life the Nicean party again began to come into difficulty. And again he setn Athanacious into exile. He had returned under Johian, five times ke in his life he was sent into exile. He was from 374, I believe that was when he died, from 326 when he became bishop until 374, nearly fifty years he was bishop and five periods of anywhere from a year to five years he was in exile, and xxxxxxxxxx in the course of them.
