We have pointed out on the map in connection with the previous indicent. When mexx did we hear of Jezreel before? How many can mention two incidents in which we heard of Jezreel before? What is one? Well, that is later; that is not before. That is an important thing at Jeareel which is yet ahead. But of what we have had already in this course? Elijah ran before Ahab from Carmel to Jezreel. You remember I pointed that out on the map. Well, now is there anything we have had in Jezreel. Naboth's vineyard was in Jezreel. The capital of Israel is in Samaria, a long xxxx distance south of Jezreel, but Jezreel is where Ahab had a summer palace and it is a secondary headquarters for the king. That is why he wanted Naboth's vineyard so he would have more room to spread out in his time of isa leisure when he was living at his vacation capital of Jezreel. So now Joram being wounded comes back not to the greeat capital where the events of state are ordinarily performed but to the vacation headquarters, to his country house in the small town of Jezreel. a considerable distance north of the big capital in Samaria. There he was in Jezreel being healed of his wounds, and not with the army. And Ahaziah, the son of Jehoram, k ng of Judah,

has come to Jezreel to see his uncle who was recovering from his wounds. Then
