People will think that the Bible is closely mouth tied up with present ideas. This did happen to a certain extent in the middle ages. People interpreted the Bible in kex terms of the world view of their day, and then when we learn to they thought that / had become know more about the universe in which we live / the Bible / became out-of-date. Actually, when we examine the Bible closely, we find that it fits with our expanding world-view much more than the smaller world-xxx view that was previously held. It is important that we know the grammatico-historical method of interpreting the Word. Let us see exactly what is there. Wheenexxx questions add Let us look at all the questions that occur mate our minds, as we look at any passage of the Scripture. And let us ask, Does the Scripture definitely teach certain things? Does the Scripture definitely deny certain Dos the Scripture make not make a statement at all in relation to this thing. Let us not build too much upon trying to squeeze any one verse p of the Scripture to the limit. Human words & knew are slippery devices. Let interpret us interpret the Scripture by Scripture, and meanth the Book as a whole. When we do so, we will find that the Bible is never out-of-date, but is constantly ahead of date. There are probably individuals today who are trying to make the interpretations of the world in that will rule x universe. However, no widely accepted cosmogony of today will really do this. Genesis 1:1 can fit with any of the widely held cosmogony of today.
