Thus, by the period of the sixties '60's a great part of the educated people of Amer° had been trained by those who hated the system. In the sixties '60's then we began to see a phenomenon ~~known~~ unknown in ~~American~~ Amer° life before. Patriotism had largely disappeared. ~~Newspapers/~~ <sup>and</sup> newspapers/ magazines constantly criticized and attacked all <sup>or</sup> who were successful/~~or~~ prominent in America. If someone went into politics he as apt it was apt to be said that he desired to work within the system. Great numbers of people who in themselves would never/~~have~~ <sup>lead</sup> movements in this direction have the feeling that the system is wrong and therefore are not ready to give direct leadership to it. This movement has now become so great and so strong that it is highly questionable whether marches and propaganda accomplish anything against it. It is only by in some way getting to the source of the system and changing ~~it~~ it that the trend which is sweeping Amer° on toward anarchism and destruction could possibly be changed.
