When I came back to Princeton I saw Dr. Machen who had not been at the assembly, but had been hearing about what happened of course. Dr. Machen was so grateful to me for expressing sympathy to him. You would think that he was a man who had been condemned to a life sentence for something that he had not done. He seemed ~~xx~~ so disturbed and disheartened. A couple of days after I was back ~~xxx~~ in Princeton I ran on to Dr. Stevenson, the president, and Dr. Stevenson said to me, "Oh," he said, "I think on the whole we came out pretty well in that assembly." He said, "All they did was to postpone Machen's appointment ~~xxxx~~ for a year's ~~x~~ consideration, and act on it to be acted on later, the next year." He said, "There were ~~xxxxxxxx~~ some there who wanted to ~~xxxxxx~~ reject it altogether on account of Machen's ~~xxx~~ money having come from liquor."

This was one of the stories that was circulated in the attack on Machen. Machen said to me, "I would hate to think that a cent of the money that I have had come from the liquor interests in any way." The ~~xxxxxxxxxx~~ Modernists would stop at ~~xxx~~ nothing, it seemed, in order to hurt Dr. Machen.
