He may not come tomorrow, and He may not come for a hundred years. He says, if we say the Lord can't come now, He won't come until 20 years from now, we have no right to say that. He may come now. Because in such an hour as ye think not, the Son of Man cometh. And the very fact that we think not, we can argue that that may be the time when He comes. He says that no man knows when He is coming, not even the Father Himself. And so we do not know when He is coming, but this is a sign described here at the end of chapter 11, which certainly indicates that His coming is nearer now than it was a hundred years ago. It indicates that very definitely. It is nearer now than it was before. And it may be very near. We don't know. And verse 16, they shall be a highway for the rest of His people. There will be a means for them to come back. Though right now you have a high way, The American Flying Tigers went down to Yemen in Arabia, two or three years ago, and in South Arabia they took great numbers of these Jews and they put them in these planes, and they carried them to the North. The Jews had been under oppression by the people of Yemen, in South Arabia. They never had enough to eat. They were thin and emascuated all their lives. They had never seen a wheeled vehicle. The first vehicle that - every thing there today is still carried by camels and donkeys. The first thing they ever saw that had a wheel on, was an airplane. And these Jews there, these Yemenite Jews had these American Flying Tigers come in, and pick them up and carry them away. And they carried them to Jerusalem and they landed in Palestine, and they were dropped off ~~(5 1/2)~~ in Palestine. They had never before seen a wheeled vehicle. But there was a highway to carry them back, with no effort on their part. The American Flying Tigers dropped them in Palestine, and left them there. And I know that there was one day when a bus was going into Jerusalem, and he wanted to stop at a little village along the way, and the driver intending to tell the people to get ready, we'll be there soon.
