Supreme Court ~~says~~ says you cannot advance Christianity by tax money.

Well, if you can't advance it, you certainly shouldn't attack it,

you certainly shouldn't advance the doctrines of humanism<sup>o</sup> that are contrary to Christianity by the use of tax money. But one of the <sup>whom</sup> leading witnesses that the University brought there was the head of the Department of Religion which has just been established in the University ~~of~~ of California. And he formerly taught at the University of Iowa (Idaho?). And he told how he had been given a year's leave of absence in order to make a study of the teaching of religion in universities, and particularly in state universities. And the evidence he presented was terrifying: to see how in our tax-supported institutions students are being compelled to take courses which tear the Bible to pieces, and teach that it is not dependable at all. Well, if the Bible isn't dependable we want to know it; we want to cast it aside. We believe the Bible will stand every test if it is treated fairly. During the last ten or fifteen years our Sunday School literature in most of our large denominations has blossomed out with teachings about the higher criticism. Moses didn't write the Pentateuch; it was written by the writers J, E, D and P hundreds of years apart and then combined together into the Bible. They have issued little booklets like this one I ~~have~~ have here, The Holy Scriptures - A Survey which combine a very pious tone with an attempt to inculcate the teaching of the higher criticism and to deny the statements of the Word of God. I went to the free library over ~~in~~ in Philadelphia and looked in the religious department, looking just at books published or printed within the last 15 years, and I found at least 20 books printed within these last 15 years presenting the higher criticism as established fact, and these included books by so-called Protestants, three or four of them ~~by~~ by Roman Catholic leaders, a number <sup>of them</sup> /by Jews, books from all sorts of viewpoints were presenting the higher criticism
