The Gospel Dispensation

Two Covenants(Works and Grace) instead of 7 dispensations, with the Covenant of Grace being divided into two dispensations or administrations

1. That of the OT
2. That of the NT

The OT Covenant of Grace is divided into four stages or covenants

1. The revelation to Adam
2. The Covenant with Noah
3. The Covenant with Abraham
4. The Sinaitic Covenant
