Desenied (1) i. g. קָרָא, קָרָא (see at the root קָרָא (an unmissed st., to be white, shining)  
 (2) an acute and clear voice; hence to neigh as a horse, Jer. 5.8, to shout for joy, to cry out (for joy), used of persons, Isa. 12.6; 54.1; Isa. 24.14

Piel, causat. of Kal No. 2 but in a bad sense, used of a cry from fear or terror.  
 Isa. 10.30 "make thy voice shrill," i. e. cry with a loud voice  
 Ps. 104.15 (Hiphil.), to cause to shine
